

All current out-of-district/transfer students must have an application submitted to attend Mt. Vernon in 2022-2023. Once a Marauder, always a Marauder (unless there are major discipline or attendance issues). However, parents/guardians must submit an application for each child during one of the two windows to continue to attend Mt. Vernon in 2022-2023. 
